Speyside

Aberlour 25ml £4.95 40% 10yo is a great entry-level malt, ideal for beginners, with a fine sherried spiciness.

Dalwhinnie 25ml £5.05 43% 15yo is a good introduction to the delights of single malt whisky. The name Dalwhinnie is derived from the Gaelic language, meaning 'meeting place'.

Lowland

Auchentoshan 25ml £5.30 40% 12yo. The name Auchentoshan is from Gaelic Achadh an t-Oisein and translates as 'the field of the corner'.

Campbeltown

Springbank 25ml £7.10 46% 15yo like a storm gathering off the Kintyre coast is dark and ominous, yet delicious. Best enjoyed after the meal, this is a true classic.

Highland Park 25ml £5.00 40% 12yo remains one of the gold- standard malts for other distillery bottlings to aspire to.

Laphroaig 25ml £5.50 40% 10yo is a full-bodied, smoky gem, with a residual sweetness and a hint of salt amid the seaweedy, peaty characters before a long warming finish.

Wolfburn 25ml £5.00 46% This is the first, and ongoing, release from the Scottish mainland's northernmost distillery. This is a light, sweet and fragrant whisky, with notes of fruit, nuts and a hint of peat.
